

Writers, take this opportunity to spin your tales and send them to our zines. (Golden Grove in particular is good at publishing Queen's Own material.) We'd love to read you stories.



An Open Note of Thanks for Misty:

I've decided I need to start doing something positive in this chaotic world right now. One of those things I want to do is send authors who've had a profound influence on me some kind of thank you.

I found Misty's books in Junior High. I was a kid who'd been reading Tamora Pierce but was out of books and who'd only found Piers Anthony and McCaffrey to read in the interim and wasn't finding the right connection. I found *Magic's Promise* on the shelf and read through it and was instantly absorbed . . . and very confused (starting on the middle book of a trilogy is never a great way to understand things). Before I found the rest of the Vanyel series I found Talia's stories and saw pieces of myself in her. And then Vanyel's books, where the bullying and isolation I felt found a match. Then Tarma and Kethry by high school and college where I recognized the hunger in me to see strong female characters in epic fantasy.

It was in college that Misty's work gave me two of the biggest gifts of my life. The first was to present a character whose identity was centered around not being sexual but being asexual. It was the very first time I'd seen or considered a character like that and it was incredibly powerful--even if it would take me another 20 years to recognize my own identity fully. I'm asexual, but all I knew then was that Tarma gave me permission to think about that possibility. Tarma was my first hint that I wasn't just broken.

The second gift was a friend. We met on campus in writing class, but ultimately discovered we were destined to be friends when she caught me reading The

Black Gryphon on a stone fence by her dorm. She was excited to know the book was out. Turns out we were both readers of Misty, though she'd been reading her Diana Tregarde series, something I hadn't read yet. Angel --that was her name--would come over and borrow books from my dorm room, and I would in turn borrow books from her. I would learn how deeply she had absorbed some of Misty's story ideologies, and how much they were a part of her own identity. She was my first real friend at school, a mercurial bisexual pagan girl from New Mexico who somehow liked hanging out with the quiet Catholic girl from Long Island who 'didn't like to date'.

She made me believe in myself when all the brain weasels tried to tell me I was worthless. She and I had mock swordfights on campus, traded filk songs, talked about writing and our lives. I didn't know it then, but I suffered from anxiety spirals that left me feeling utterly disconnected from everyone--and she wouldn't let me stay there. There was one scene from my memory--I was in the cafeteria feeling utterly crushed and alone amid the noise and bustle. Nobody noticed or cared. And then she swooped in with "guerilla hugs" for me and told me I was looking so despondent she was intent on cheering me up. She was a song that filled my heart and answered a piece of myself and made me believe for the first time in my life that the girl who had been bullied and ostracized in high school might just have a chance at getting this friendship thing right.

I had one glorious year at school with her. We promised to write and call over the summer and did but infrequently. And I was crushed when the new school year began to find she couldn't come back to college. Too much money--her father wanted her to go local. And then . . . I found out in October she'd taken her own life. It shattered me in a way nothing else has or will. I mourned. I blamed myself. And finally, I helped another girl go through her items in storage on campus to send things back home. But I kept a few of her writing pieces, a chewed pencil, a recipe for bread she'd written by hand. She's never quite left my life since, and every time I read Misty's work, it's like she's reading over my shoulder.

As sorrowful as her loss has been, and still is despite the 24 years since, I'm grateful for the gift of her memory, of that year. I like to think she'd be proud of the life I've made. I'm a mom, and a librarian and still a reader. And I will always treasure those past moments and all the books we shared.

So, Misty, thank you for being part of the blueprint of my life, and giving me these gifts to keep.

Contest Announcement


