


### **Story Prompt:**





#### **Book Review**

Lackey, Mercedes. 1989. Magic's Pawn. New York, NY: Daw Books, Inc.

This is one of my favorite books by Mercedes Lackey. It contains Vanyel Ashkevron, the first gay character I ever encountered in Fantasy fiction. It's a real tear-jerker, so have a box of Kleenex handy when you read it.

The story follows Vanyel from the time he is sixteen, through his first love, and onto his being Chosen by the Companion Yfandes who helps him get his special powers under control until he can be trained by the Hawkbrothers, the Tayledras. Vanyel's tortuous relationship with his father, Within, recalls the fight many of my gay friends have experienced in real life. The prejudice he has to deal with among his fellow nobles and Heralds at court also has a familiar ring to it.

Other gay characters include Starwind and Moonstar k'Treva who teach Vanyel how to use his Mage Gift, something that was far too strong for Vanyel's aunt, Herald Mage Savil, to help him control.

If you're interested, the Vanyel Fan Club on Facebook is currently working it's way through the text. We're about halfway into the book, so there's still time to catch up. All the rest is spoilers, so if you haven't read it, enjoy! If you have, enjoy it again. It's well worth the read.
