
Book Reviews

This edition's reviews are by Herald Shayla and Herald-Mage Adept Danya Winterborn.


Valdemar: From DAW, published in 2023. The third book of the Founding of Valdemar trilogy takes us ten years after Baron Valdemar led his people to the Vale that became Haven. Much of the first part of the book deals with building structures that we've come to know and love as well as establishing the social structure, with things like the Watch being appointed to guard neighborhoods so the Guard can take care of other things (mostly the Palace at this point). There's an ongoing campaign to make Kordas king, something that he keeps refusing, though we all know that he eventually loses that battle. We finally get to see the summoning of the Companions. (For all who are curious, to walk "widdershins" means to move counterclockwise.) The evil mage who is threatening the new kingdom is an old foe of the Tayledras, so the Valdemarans and Tayledras once again team up to fight the threat from without. The biggest piece of advice I have is to reread the first two books before diving into the new one. There are many references I didn't get the first time through because it had been so long since I'd read them in the other books. I hope Misty starts another trilogy after this one, dealing with the reign of Kordas's son, because his storyline is left sort of hanging. Otherwise, it's an excellent read. -- Danya
