Review of Mercedes Lackey's *Phoenix and Ashes* (DAW 2004), by Linda A. Malcor. Paperback, 468 Pages.

Phoenix and Ashes follows The Serpent's Shadow and The Gates of Sleep in the Elemental Master's series. Set in World War I, the story of Cinderella takes on several twists in this intriguing novel. Misty has really done her homework as far as the folklore is concerned. She demonstrates knowledge of several old variants of the tale as well as of British fairy lore in general (I suspect she may have been reading Katharine Brigg's excellent survey of *British Folktales.*). It's a rare book that I can, as a professional folklorist, can find few complaints about, but Misty really hit a home run with this one.

Misty is developing an interesting idea about how certain kinds of magic are encouraging war and feeding off the results in this parallel universe where elementals partner with humans. She also demonstrates a keen knowledge of how people interact with each other in historical social situations. While I've seen some critics accuse Misty of imposing modern sensibilities on the past, I think what she is doing in these works is much more interesting. I refuse to believe that everyone in the past was cut out of some cardboard form, and the more I study history, the more I come to think that we're not all that different from our ancestors.

I found myself comparing this work to the Saint Germain novels by Chelsea Quinn Yarbro, which I dearly love. No, there's no vampire anywhere in site, but the historical research was every bit as good, and I definitely enjoyed it.

So if you're looking for a bit of summer reading with some educational content, you should definitely pick up this book!
