# From Herald-Mage Adept Danya Winterborn:

Heyla!

Following Moonstar's clever idea, here are my answers to the interview questions:

#### 1. Tell us about your family.

I am now divorced after 25-1/2 years of marriage, so I'm trying to get my feet back under me. Looking to hang out with friends. (I seem to be cursed to make friends mostly with people on the other side of the globe!) Seriously not interested in another relationship at the moment. (It is truly amazing how many young men from Africa want to marry me, have me adopt them or do something else that would possibly get them into the US.)

My eldest son, Joe, just graduated from high school and has his first job: a ride operator at an amusement park. He went to the same high school as Moonstar's son, Xander.

My daughter, Kassie, just finished her freshman year at the same high school. She's almost ready to start on her Gold Award for Girl Scouts. She volunteers at the Orange County Bird of Prey Center, taking care of hawks, owls, and other raptors. She has also worked with wolfdogs, including on the music video for *Into the Woods*. (Can someone help me convince her to read Misty's books? She's at that age where she won't listen to her mother ©.)

My youngest son, John, spends much of his free time gaming online. He is in Middle School, where his favorite topic is history. (Only ask him about the Byzantine Empire if you have lots and lots of time to listen!)

My sable-and-white rough collie, Dux, has become quite the old man. He's 10-1/2 now and spends much of his time lying around, listening to me type.

#### 2. What is your educational background?

Let's see if I can get this all in one sentence: I have a B.A. in English with minors in Comparative Literature and History from Occidental College, a Master's in Folklore and Mythology with an emphasis on Narrative and Celtic Studies, and a Ph.D. in Folklore and Mythology with an emphasis on Medieval Studies and Indo-European Comparative Mythology (the latter two degrees from UCLA). (Can I come up for air now?)

#### 3. Why did you choose to save Queen's Own?

I adore Misty's books, particularly the ones set in Valdemar. I enjoy working with fans, and I have met some of my best friends (and business associates!) through Queen's Own. I just couldn't stand the thought of there not being a Queen's Own club anymore.

#### 4. When did you join Queen's Own?

The records say I created Danya in 1996, so that's probably when I joined. (I'm not one to sit around when someone challenges me to create a character.)

## 5. What got you hooked on Misty's books?

A friend gifted me with a copy of *Magic's Pawn*, when he realized Vanyel was gay. (Back then my friend had issues with gays; now he has been celebrating the SCOTUS decision to legalize same-sex marriage. Times change. So do people.) I loved Vanyel so much that I promptly started buying everything by Misty that I could get my hands on. (Yes, I bought them. Misty's books were far too good for me to check out of a library and return.) I'm still buying, though she can write faster than I have time to read these days. I will get to the rest of them eventually!

#### 6. What else do you read?

Oh, dear. It's probably faster to ask about what I don't read. Science fiction, fantasy fiction, historical fiction, archaeology, history, Roman inscriptions . . . I can read a couple dozen languages, so if I'm not typing, I usually have my nose in a book. (Haven't gotten into computer texts too much. My laptop hurts my nose when I fall asleep while reading and it falls on my face.)

#### 7. What types of music do you listen to?

Show tunes, classic rock, John Williams (!), Sondheim, ballads, folksongs, country, mostly anything that comes with a story.

#### 8. What was the first con you went to?

Eep! I don't remember. (It's a side-effect of old age.) It may have been a Battlestar Galactica Con. One of the best ones I've been to was a Star Trek Con. (I messed with everyone's mind by showing up as Herald-Mage Adept Danya Winterborn, and I had a blast telling them about Misty when they asked which episode of Star Trek I was from  $\odot$ .)

#### 9. What other projects besides Queen's Own occupy your time?

I'm a professional writer and researcher. I mostly work on the legends of King Arthur, the Knights of the Round Table and the Holy Grail. I was the researcher for Bruckheimer's King Arthur (2004). Movies, nonfiction articles, short stories, novels (*Dragon Heart* should be out in a couple of months; Queen's Own member Laura Cameron is illustrating!), and anything else anyone asks me to write.

I'm heavily into social justice work and human rights. While my efforts are usually centered on LGBT issues, I've recently found myself up to my neck in the case of a fellow writer, Raif Badawi, who is in jail in Saudi Arabia, sentenced to 10 years in prison, a 10 year travel ban upon release, a million riyal fine (over a quarter million dollars), and 1000 lashes, of which he has already received 50. His crime is that he wrote a blog (The Saudis decided that made him guilty of "cyber-terrorism".). I recently helped organize a protest against his sentence outside the Saudi embassy in Los Angeles. If you haven't heard of him, Google his name. There is quite the international outcry about the case. (Yes, that "Herald" streak still runs strong in me.)

#### 10. What do you like the best about Queen's Own?

I love the like-minded people I get to meet, the wonderful conversations we have, and the exciting projects (writing or otherwise) that we get to work on together.
