Heyla, Misty fans!

I hope this newsletter finds you all well. I'm sorry it's a bit late, but April was more than a little hectic, what with Easter, two Spring Breaks for my kids that did not coincide, and my conference at UC Berkeley. I was hoping that things would calm down a bit in May, but, glancing at my calendar, I don't think I'm going to be that lucky <g>. Oh, well. At least life's never boring these days!

Please note that there has been a change of address for High Flight. Misty asks that we send our releases for fan fiction to:

The two High Flight addresses on the website do not work anymore, and I haven't been able to update them yet because of all the trouble we're having with our service provider.

Speaking of trouble, yes, the website has been down more often than not during the last month. (And it's still up and down and up and down and up and . . .::sigh::) Yes, the lists are back working. No, I haven't been able to update the content of the website since roughly December. Yes, I'm very annoyed with our provider, but I can't move the service because the domain name is pointed to our provider instead of to me. ::sigh:: Working on it . . . Hopefully everything will get sorted out in the next month or so.

This year the club's ranks have reached 587 people with approved Queen's Own personae: 476 Heralds, 9 Herald-Mages, 30 Bards, 1 Blue,

3 Guards, 22 Healers, 3 Mercenaries, 11 Shin'a'in, 4 Sorceresses, 34 Tayledras and 2 "other" folks (bear in mind that the numbers don't entirely add up because of some crossover characters: Our 6 Shin'a'in Heralds, 1 Herald-Sorceress and 1 Shin'a'in-Mercenary. Also, we can't forget about our 30 NPC's: 16 Heralds, 4 Bards, 4 Healers, 1 Shin'a'in-Herald, 1 Kal-enedral and 4 Tayledras characters. We have 122 active members, 16 of whom are on the QO chatlist for announcements between newsletters ... so sign up if you're not on the list already, to be the first to hear about Misty sightings, RPGs and other club goings-on. There are currently 65 people working on personae, and 8 in the process of getting personae approved (2 Bards, 3 Heralds, and 3 Tayledras). We have 11 active QO Chapters, including 2 online chapters; the Vanyel Fan Club topping off the list with 105 members. There are still chapters up for adoption if you're interested.

Publication News:

On May 2, Misty's work will appear in *The Dragon Quintet* alongside authors Tanith Lee, Michael Swanwick, Elizabeth Moon and Orson Scott Card. The same day, look for *Sanctuary* (the third in Misty's Joust trilogy) in paperback.

For those who want to plan ahead on summer reading, *Bedlam's Bard* will be released in paperback on June 30, followed by the final book in Misty's Obsidian Mountain collaboration with James Mallory, *When Darkness Falls*, which will be available July 25.

Three new fall release dates have been announced: Look for the latest in Misty's Joust series, *Aeirie*, in hardback and the fourth Elemental Masters installment, *The Wizard of London*, in paperback on October 3. Plus, on Halloween, a new paperback release of the Diana Tregarde tale, *Jinx High*, will hit shelves in time for you to celebrate.

Around the corner on November 7, *Ill Met By Moonlight*, Misty's collaboration with Roberta Gellis, hits shelves in paperback.

One Good Knight by Mercedes Lackey (Luna, 2006). Review by Anne Morgan.

I've just finished one of Misty's newest books, *One Good Knight*, and it is really wonderful! Some of you may have been a little suspicious about it as it is a Luna publication and so is designated as Romance Fantasy. I was a little at first. But not to worry: It is in the fine tradition of the Elemental books, and you'll love every minute of it.

One Good Knight is a novel of the Five Hundred Kingdoms and is actually the second book in the series, the first being *The Fairy Godmother*. While two characters from this book do make a guest appearance, you don't have to have read the first book to read the second one (although you should read it, too; it answers the age old question of what the Godmothers do when they're not popping in to help fairy tale happy endings). The premise in the Five Hundred Kingdoms is that fairy tales do happen, both the happy Disney kind and the Grimm kind, thanks to something called the Tradition. The Tradition pushes certain things to happen to create the fairy tales and Godmothers can either use this and help Traditions create happy endings or try to alter the Tradition and prevent the Grimm versions from happening to good people.

None of this has ever touched the happy little Kingdom of Acadia, however. Many people don't even believe in the Tradition, and those who do figure it's just ignoring them. Among those is the Princess Andromeda, daughter of Queen Cassiopeia. "Andie", as she prefers to be called, enjoys reading and exploring, visiting her friends in the Guards and generally doing everything that is considered "improper" for a young lady--especially for a Princess! Her mother rarely pays her any attention

except to point out her deficiencies (She's hardly beautiful, especially when compared to her mother, which makes her a constant disappointment to Cassiopeia). But just when Andie is finding her place in the royal court, the Tradition comes to pay a visit.

What would be more traditional for a small, innocent kingdom than to have a dragon come and ravage the countryside? No one knows how to get rid of the beast until Andie finds the Traditional answer--virgin sacrifices--while waiting for a Champion to come and slay the dragon. One of the things I admired most was the emotional impact Misty gave this idea. In myths and fairy tales the sacrifices get staked out for dinner, and everybody leaves seeming to not care at all. But Andie cares and feels responsible for sending the girls to their deaths. The people are all serious and sympathetic when the procession passes by to deliver the victim, and even those putting the girl out are sympathetic enough to offer her a drug that will put her in her own little painless world so she will be less afraid when the dragon comes.

While this may be all Andie thinks is happening, of course more is going on in the background. Cassiopeia and her advisor/magician Solon are causing troubles to get treasure that somehow never makes it to the official records. When people begin to grumble against Cassiopeia, it is their daughters who are chosen "at random" to go to the dragon. And when Andie begins to wonder about these little coincidences, the jealous Cassiopeia decides the answer to her problems with Andie as well as the people who are noticing the pattern of sacrifices is quite simple: Andromeda will be the next one "randomly" chosen by lottery to go to the dragon. And while Andie spends most of the book in some form of denial that her mother would actually *choose* to have her daughter eaten by a dragon, give her credit: She's not so naive when it comes to getting away! With help from her friends she goes to the stake well prepared to free herself and run away once the people have left, and it's just her and the dragon. There is the small problem of getting herself untied before the dragon grabs her, but, in Traditional fashion, the Champion arrives just in time and fights the dragon while Andie takes care of freeing herself and hiding for her life.

I absolutely refuse to spoil any of the surprises from here on out. This was a fun and fast read but full of all the little details Misty specializes in to make you feel like you're right there with the characters. Andie is a weaker Rose from *The Fire Rose* but still manages to break away from that model on occasion. As for the love story? It's a lovely subtle type that until the last minute you're not entirely sure is going to work (or even get acknowledged!). But that's what Godmothers are for.
