How I Finally Turned One of Larry Dixon's Drawings into a Costume

As always DragonCon was crowded. Last year I believe the attendance count was somewhere around 70,000 people, and this year the crowds looked at least as big. I had difficulties dealing with the crowds this year. Not sure if that's because I was by myself or just because it's been a rough year for that. The result was I didn't stay downtown past 6pm and I missed out on several of the more popular panels I wanted to see. I did catch several of Larry and Misty's panels, and their signing on Friday night. If you were at the signing or in the Hyatt on Saturday, I'm the one who made the Herald's Whites, or more affectionately known as "the white monstrosity."





The story behind the creation of the costume goes back several years, to around the time the 2nd or 3rd Mags book came out. I was doing a chronological reread and was on Brightly Burning when Larry's drawing for chapter 15 caught my attention. Look at those pleats! What does the rest of it look like? Could you even make curved pleats? These questions and a million more plagued me for months. Flash forward to 2016 and I have my very first chance to attend DragonCon. I knew Larry and Misty would be there so during the Sunday signing I screwed up my courage and asked Larry if he could finish the tunic so I could try and turn it into a costume. He was amazingly enthusiastic about the idea; amazing to me anyway – a lowly accountant who dabbles in costuming.



A year, five or six mockups and a whole lot of hair pulling later I was able to present the final product to Larry and Misty at the Friday night signing. They were both very pleased with the results, Larry even offered to autograph it for me, but since the tunic is machine washable he had to settle for signing my copy of Brightly Burning.

For those of you who are interested in such things, the tunic is made from French linen and cotton. I purchased the linen and white and silver trim at the L.A. garment district. The blue cotton lining and white cotton flannel interlining of the cape came from a local fabric store. The

while cotton muslin lining of the tunic I got in England with the idea of using it for a very different project that I'm no longer interested in. The pants and shirt I wore were store bought, for other purposes, because in working so hard on the tunic I never really got around to figuring out what I wanted for those. I have since come up with an idea for the pants and am starting to get a tickling about the shirt, so maybe I'll get those done in the next year or two. This is not a field tunic, it's for summer court or collegium wear and I do have plans to do a field tunic of leather, but I'll have to save up for that.

As for what was said during the panels about the next Valdemar book, everything I can remember about that has already been mentioned on the Facebook pages. Something about Mag's and Amilie's kids and the Scooby gang. Which means I need to go back and finish reading the anthologies, because I don't remember Scooby, Shaggy and the rest making an appearance? Or maybe it was in one of the Mags books. My memory is not what it was.

DragonCon Review by Herald Nalei Rayskeline:

I follow authors like some people follow actors: reading blogs, twitter and Facebook, and collecting autographs. I have quite a few from my favorite authors that I've collected over the last few years, but one has eluded me for some time: Misty's. Mostly because I've lived on the west coast until recently, and she doesn't do a lot of signings. Naturally the year I move to Nashville is the year Misty does three signings in southern California (where I used to live). That's why I always wanted to go to DragonCon, because I knew she appeared there most years. Moving to Nashville made going to DragonCon easier, since I could drive down instead of fly. Still I wasn't planning on attending this year because I'm in the middle of buying a house, until I found out I was on a panel about Victorian era food, less than three weeks before the convention.

I have to say DragonCon is the biggest con I have ever been to, and I found it a bit overwhelming the first day. I saw one panel a friend was part of and spent the rest of the evening people watching and just walking around to get the lay of the land so I wouldn't get lost as I tried to make my way between hotels for panels. Saturday my friends and I got a late start, in part because the parade was going to be televised on CW for the first time ever and we decided to watch it that way instead of fighting the crowds and trying to get up before the sun. We were also waiting on some other friends we were sharing our hotel room with who got a late start and wouldn't be in until sometime between 9 and 10. They finally made it around 11. That morning we discovered we had found the one hotel in all of Atlanta that didn't have CW in its selection of cable channels. (How does that even work? Someone who has cable please let me know.) I survive on Amazon, Netflix and free Hulu so I don't know much about cable or dish and how they can exclude a free channel.

Saturday afternoon I made it to one of Misty's panels, the one called "Fantasy Lit Changed My Life" with Misty, Larry, Christopher Paolini and Chris A. Jackson. I think the moderator was Angelina Adams, but I'm not sure and the app won't give me the other speakers option anymore. This was the only panel of Misty's I made it to, but it was great and I'm glad I did. There was a lot of humor, the moderator did a good job of keeping things on point when they veered into the risqué. It was nice to have a mix of young and more established authors and hear them talk about changing universes versus staying in the same one and how that affects their writing. Someone, I can't remember if it was Larry or Misty said something about the next book having, or being about Kelvren.

After more people watching, meeting a man who had designated himself DragonCon's official admiration society while charging his phone in a hall and watching more people in Deadpool mash-up costumes than I knew was possible I headed off to my panel on food. Sunday I had only two things on my list: braving the dealer rooms, and Misty and Larry's signing. Then I had to make the drive home so I could do all the adult things I'd been putting off all weekend.

The dealer rooms were packed, at least the first two floors were. However, I found a wig for my Lord of the Rings elf costume, got all three tairn from CL Wilson's booth (if you haven't tried her books and you like fantasy romance they are great!), met an author named Nick Braker who was selling his book and looking for fantasy/sci-fi cons for authors (If anyone knows of any please email them to me at <u>sn.keeper@yahoo.com</u> and I will pass them on), had a brief conversation with Chris Jackson about romance relationships in fantasy works (we are both in agreement that since romantic relationships are a part of life they should be in fantasy works, even if the work is not intended to be a romance), spoke to someone from Ultra Sabers about the saber I want for my new Clone Wars Jedi (It's going to be expensive), ogled the costumes of UDReplicas (and I thought the saber was expensive), and picked up cards for a bunch of artists to commission works to replace my movie poster collection (It's more than time). And then it was off to the Marriott for my signing.

Finding the signing room was not the easiest thing, not just because there were few signs, but because even the volunteer staff didn't always know where everything in the hotel they were working in was. I ended up asking 4 staff, the information booth and a bunch of attendees before finding Misty, Larry and Timothy Zahn. This was the highlight of the con for me since I got to speak to both Larry and Misty without hyperventilating, or panicking, and was coherent enough to get my questions answered. Thank you to the very nice Air Force Sergeant standing in front of me in line I can't remember your name, but it was good talking to you and your Army friend. The most important question (for those of us in Queen's Own) where to send our stories written in Misty's universe. She said to use the creative commons license form, but gave no address. Below is the picture of her note, in her own hand. The other question involves an illustration Larry did for one of the Velgarth books that inspired me to attempt to recreate the garments, the only problem is it's only about half the picture. Apparently Larry's been doing some costume design recently and was intrigued by my interest. Hopefully I'll actually be able to get this costume done in the near future, I come up with costume ideas the way some people come up with story ideas. If I do I'll write something up and post pictures for Queen's Own.






